Courts ruled that websites and digital platforms are places of public accommodation under the ADA.

 Other applicable laws: Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act and Section 255 of the Communications Act



Globally, 253 million people have vision impairments.





Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) Most Updated Version 2.2

- Compatibility with screen readers. Visit <u>UCSF Screen Reader Demo</u> to learn more.
 - Common screen readers: JAWS, <u>NVDA</u>, <u>VoiceOver</u>
- Provide a text alternative
- Provide closed captioning

WCAG – Perceivable Continued

- Use readable text, font size, and character count
 - Read Me | Read Me | READ ME
- Check for color contrast ratio 4.5:1. Visit <u>WebAim Color Contrast Checker</u> to learn more.
 - Pure red (#FF0000) with white (#FFFFFF)
 - Pure green (#00FF00) with white (#FFFFFF)
 - Pure blue (#0000FF) with white (#FFFFFF)

WCAG - Operable

- Provide a clear structure with headings
- Create descriptive links
 - Avoid "click here" or "learn more".
- Check for keyboard accessibility
 - Press **Tab** to navigate to interactive elements
 - Press Shift and Tab to navigate in the opposite direction

WCAG - Understanding

- Indicate the document language
 - "He maintained that the GDR (German Democratic Republic) was just a 'Treppenwitz der Weltgeschichte'.
 - An HTML Web page includes links to versions of the page in other languages.

WCAG - Robust

- Provide descriptive metadata (e.g., descriptive title)
- Perform an accessibility check
 - Mobile Testing Guide for Android & iOS (The Paciello Group)
- Involve people with visual impairments in accessibility

WCAG + Teaching others how to use built-in features = Best Practice







Inaccessible PowerPoint

Manage with Selection Pane


Home tab → Arrange → Selection Pane
