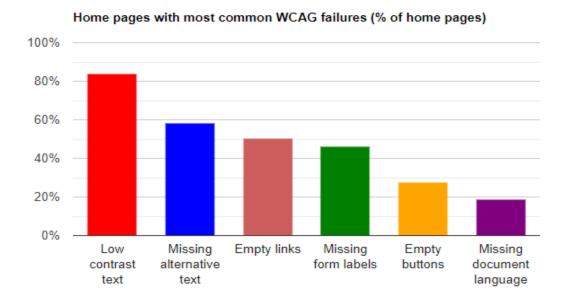
Accessibility Benchmarks

Website Accessibility

The WebAIM Million (https://webaim.org/projects/million/) is WebAIM's accessibility evaluation of the home pages for the top 1,000,000 web sites.

- The one million home pages assessed had an average of 50.0 errors per page.
- Government home pages had an average of 28.6 errors per page. Government home pages had on average far fewer errors than home pages for other sectors.
- Most conformance failures fall into six categories, as shown below.



PDF Accessibility

 Over 250 blind and low-vision assistive technology users across the United reported that 67% of PDFs they encountered were either partially or entirely unreadable.
