

**1. How often would you like the Education Council to meet?**

- I could meet monthly if the agenda warranted it. Some may have to be conducted via distance.
- Additional meetings if necessary

**2. What day of the week would you like the Education Council to meet?**

- Not Wednesdays
- or Friday
- Probably works best on Thursday p.m. as I often have meetings in Lincoln on Friday morning.
- First Thursday of a given month

**3. What time of day would you like the Education Council to meet?**

- Again, the afternoon of Thursdays work probably the best.
- Times dependent on location, drive time, other events, etc.

**4. Task groups are an increasingly important part of the Education Council's activities. When would you like task groups to do their work?**

- It might work well to have the task force meetings just prior to the Ed Council meetings, like 10 a.m. - 12 p.m.
- Task groups may require more frequent contact and should not be limited

**5. Who should be primarily responsible for developing the meeting agendas of the Education Council?**

- I think all should be given opportunity to give input to the Co-Chairs to eventually formulate the agenda.
- IT Manager should coordinate, but input from all.

**7. What other comments would you like to offer concerning meeting frequency and the work of the Education Council?**

- Additional meetings will cause members to reconsider their commitment to the group. The Ed Council should be primarily a policy group--meetings that get too technical will be avoided, and quorums will be more difficult to get.
- Once we have the information from this survey I would appreciate developing a meeting schedule and process for agendas for the next year.
- The Ed Council would have to shoulder a greater responsibility to give input to the agenda and to speak to the items on the agenda. It sounds good in theory, but the practice of the theory wanes in light of operational loads of the council members.
