

# Future Ready Nebraska

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## Framework

Nebraska is intending to adopt the Future Ready framework as a structure of organizing and communicating Future Ready Nebraska plan. The framework was developed by the Alliance for Excellent Education, a Washington, DC-based national policy and advocacy organization dedicated to ensuring that all students, particularly those who are traditionally underserved, graduate from high school ready for success in college, work, and citizenship. The research-based framework is based on a vision oriented, pedagogy driven and children focused approach.

The Framework identifies 7 key categories, or gears, designed for Digital Learning visioning, planning, and implementation focused on Personalized Student Learning..

These include:

1. Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment
2. Use of Space and Time
3. Robust Infrastructure
4. Data and Privacy
5. Community Partnerships
6. Personalized Professional Learning
7. Budget and Resources
